Supply List

Box It Up II Pattern (required) – This pattern is for 3 boxes, small square box- 5 ½” square x 2 ¾ “, large square box- 7 ½ “x 3 ¼” high, tall box-5 ½” square x 5” high. We can make a group order for the guild with a discount of 20% and free shipping from stitchinsis.com.

This pattern specifically states that directional fabric is not recommended. Barbara has figured out a way to use directional border fabric to make the boxes. A border fabric that has a pattern that is around 2-4 inches high will work best for the box sides.

Fabric Requirements to make:	Large Square Box	All 3 boxes
Main Fabric (box sides)	½ yd*	1 yd*
Bottom Fabric (for border fabric box)	~ 9” x 9”	Fat Qtr.
Lining Fabric (box inside)	Fat Qtr.	½ yd
Top trim/casing Fabric	Fat Qtr.	2/3 yd
Fusible Fleece (or low loft batting)	at least 14” x 14”	½ yd
Décor Bond (Pellon 809)	½ yd	1 ¼ yd

*This amount of fabric may be necessary to match borders.

Other supplies:

- ∞ Sewing Machine (with zig zag ability and a walking foot)
- ∞ standard sewing supplies
- ∞ wonder clips or binding clips
- ∞ Jeans/denim (90/14) machine needle
- ∞ chalk marker or Pilot Frixion gel pen
- ∞ Thread for piecing; Thread for quilting
- ∞ Thread for zig zag (match or contrast your lining fabric and/or casing fabric – this will show)
- ∞ Fusing cloth (whatever you like to use to protect the iron)
- ∞ Metal tape measure will be provided
- ∞ Rotary mat and cutter (some mats will be available in the hall)

Snap Bag

Pattern possibilities:

1. Snap Happy - bring 2 coordinating fat quarters and 1/6 yd. fabric or scraps
2. Piece & Snap - 3 fat quarters and light weight fusible interfacing. Orphan bits of pieced fabrics or border prints work well in this pattern
3. The Keeper - 1/6 yd. fabric or scraps
(Select 1 pattern after looking at them online at stitchinsis.com – this will be combined with the Box pattern order)

These bags can be made to any size and are a great way to use up scrap fabric. The Piece & Snap incorporates a center accent strip for a traditional quilting touch. The Keeper is made of vinyl pet mesh and really flies together. The colored vinyl and thoughtfully chosen fabric casing make adorable bags. Batting - Fusible fleece if you want, or Kathy will supply batting scraps

The bags and the boxes can be made with vinyl mesh which will be available for purchase. Roberta is also generously donating her supply of vinyl mesh which you are welcome to use.
